Team Leaders will all meet in advance of the Creek Week clean-up to discuss and coordinate their responsibilities. Time and place of this meeting will be determined at a later date. The Team leaders would also come early to each of their respective Creek Week events to help set up in advance.

There will be a team leader for each of the following Markham Ravine and Auburn Ravine cleanup day responsibilities. The actual clean-up day will be Saturday, April 28th, 2007.

- Ravine Clean up teams. We will break up into five, or more, smaller groups. Each of these groups will be designated a certain area of the Markham Ravine, Auburn Ravine and Doty Ravine for cleanup. Each group will have a team leader
- Parking. Parking is at a premium on City streets. Many volunteers will be coming from a distance. If possible, volunteers will be encouraged to car pool to the clean-up staging areas.
- Picking up the donated luncheon food on Saturday morning.
- Setting up sign-in tables at each of the staging areas, to include Markham Park, the Savannah Street bridge and Auburn Ravine (Moore Road parking lot).
- Distribution of the Creek Week 2007 t-shirts to each of the volunteers (organized, so only one t-shirt per person).

- Distribution of raffle tickets to each of the volunteers. Each volunteer will be eligible to win very nice sponsor donated prizes.
- Getting lunch ready (including grilling of the hot dogs which will be donated).
- Clean up after lunch
- Arranging for coolers and ice for the donated bottled water and sodas.
- Overseeing trash drop-off points. Making sure debris being picked up is being placed into designated areas.
- Overseeing the cleanliness of three portable toilets located alongside the ravine clean-up areas.
- Overseeing the tools needed for Creek Week cleanup and weeding (collecting, organizing, distributing to the volunteers, and return upon completion)
